I was the Jupiter House Captain and Chairman of the Senior Choir in 1971 – 1972, and a keen member of the School Table-tennis Team.</p> <p>I graduated from the Hong Kong Polytechnic University with an Advanced Higher Diploma in Quantity Surveying and subsequently I obtained a MSc in Construction Law and Dispute Resolution with Distinction in the same University.</p> <p>I have worked in an International Professional Quantity Surveying Company for over 36 years and I have been a Director of the Company for the last 18 years. Apart from being a Registered Professional Quantity Surveyor, I am also a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrator, a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Directors as well as an Accredited Mediator.</p> <p>Since I completed my F.5 class in 1973 I joined the Alumni Association as one of the Executive Committee members and became Vice-Chairman in 1975.</p>		

I joined the Alumni Choir in 1990 and have always been a convener of the Alumni Choir for participating in School Anniversary Concerts and organizing Alumni Concerts.

Every year, attending the St. Mark's Day Celebration, Speech Day, Music Fiesta and Christmas Candlelight Service are the School events which I normally go to.

I am honored that I was awarded an Honorable Membership by the Alumni Association in 2010.

I have some connections with Education:

1. In work, some of the recent educational construction projects handled by me as Quantity Surveyor of the Clients are the Centennial Campus of the University of Hong Kong and the Academic and Administration Building of the City University of Hong Kong.
